“Safe Return to In-Person Instruction Plan”

In Person Instruction:

MALC school will follow CDC, Federal, State, and AZ State Charter Board guidelines to continuity in-school student instruction and continuity of services to maintain the health and safety of students, educators, and other staff. This includes the following:

- Providing hand sanitizer for students, teachers, staff, as well as visitors.
- Face masks are available by request and required when mandated.
- Teacher plexiglass-shields were placed in front of teacher desk/ office secretaries.
- Cleaning staff has cleaners and 99.9% alcohol for killing flu germs.
- Handwashing training to all students, teachers, and staff.
- Separated students in classrooms.
- Isolated food in separate containers for lunch, for example (salad fixings)
- Continue use of “Positive Action” program for student social, emotional, mental health needs.
- Counselor/s available for students.

Modifying Facilities:

- Improved filters in air ventilators in each room.
- Building extended outside eating and classroom area for more distance between students.
- Installing a storage area closure to classrooms and gym for cleaning supplies.
- Installing gates to keep a safer campus.
- Additional playground to increase student contact area.

Students’ Academic Needs:

- IXL online academic program purchased for three years to support student online learning Math, English, and Science.
- Teacher aides were provided opportunity to attain a Substitute certificate.
- Teacher’s had applied training time to learn additional online resources.
- Packets provided for students without technology support from home.
- Used computers purchased for students without computers at home. Community provided free internet for a few months for students.

Bi-Annual Review
