- All our schools Participate in the National School Breakfast & Lunch Programs.
- All breakfast & lunch meals served meet the new meal pattern requirements.
- All schools ensure that meals are served in clean & pleasant surroundings and are administered by a team of nutrition professionals.
- Free, drinkable water is available to all students at all schools during the meal period.
- All foods & drinks advertised on school campuses during the school day meet the USDA Smart Snack Standards at all of our schools.

- Our district reviews wellness policy compliance once every three years.
- Our Wellness Policy was updated in 2022.
- Our schools completed the School Health Index to assess implementation of the wellness policy at each school.
