We have EXCITING NEWS!!! Mohave Accelerated Schools will be transitioning from Distance Learning to a Hybrid Learning model. What that means to you is that we want to encourage every “healthy” student to return to campus starting Monday, September 28th. We also understand a few families will not be able to return immediately during the hybrid transition. The option to distance learn will continue, with changes. Our teachers will no longer interactively livestream their classes but direct their instruction to the students before them. For the families that want to continue with distance learning, class work will be sent home via Teams, Class Dojo, or Synergy, like last Spring. You will have access to your classroom teacher(s) via email or by an arranged appointment. Friday school will continue for all students with failing grades (7th – 12th grade).

It is important to note that all CDC Health Guidelines will remain in effect during this new transition to reduce the spread of COVID-19. Students and parents will always be required to wear a mask on campus, except when social distancing is possible outside. We will continue to social distance and take regular temperature checks throughout the day. The schools will continue to be transparent if any student or staff member comes within contact of another person displaying COVID like symptoms, or a positive case has been verified.

Our goal is to continue to help reduce the spread of COVID-19, while still providing you the best education safely. We will all continue to work together for the safety of every person at Mohave Accelerated Schools. This news puts us one step closer to returning to in-person instruction and getting our schools back to normal.
